House Scorecard Key:

"Right to Enjoyment of Life." HB 2797.

This legislation defined life as starting "at the moment of fertilization." If the U.S. Supreme Court overturned Roe v. Wade, this bill would have the effect of outlawing abortion in Virginia. This bill could also have the effect of outlawing many forms of birth control and even stem cell research and assisted reproduction techniques. Failed 53-43. A pro-choice vote (+) was against this bill. 2/5/07

Targeted Regulation of Abortion Providers. HB 1883.

This legislation would have required clinics that provide abortions to comply with the same standards as "ambulatory surgery centers" - or mini hospitals - in order to be licensed by the Virginia Health Planning Board. The intent of this legislation was to require such costly modifications that the facilities would be forced to either close or cease to provide abortions. Passed 60-25. A pro-choice vote (+) was against this bill. (1/23/07)

Medicaid Funding of Abortion in Cases of Rape and Incest. Budget Amendment 4-5.04.

This amendment would have prohibited the General Assembly from continuing its Medicaid funding for abortions for poverty-stricken women in cases of rape, incest and profound fetal abnormality. Passed 69-25. A pro-choice vote (+) was against this amendment. (2/8/07)

Anesthesia for Fetuses. HB 2456

This legislation would have required that a woman having an abortion at 20 weeks or later in a pregnancy be given information on fetal anesthesia and that she be told that the fetus is likely to feel pain. Requiring fetal anesthesia projects a misleading level of certainty regarding the current level of scientific knowledge on fetal pain and may compromise a woman's safety and pose risks to her health. Passed 69-29. A pro-choice vote (+) was against this bill. (2/6/07)
